Purpose of this Meeting – Initiate CEQA Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Process

CEQA

- Statewide environmental review law
- Frequently results in EIR completion and public review

University of California CEQA Role

- Lead agency for CEQA projects proposed by UC Davis
- Identify potential issues early in the environmental review process

California Tower-major hospital facility project

- Proposed for patient care and seismic safety
- EIR to assess potential environmental effects



Purpose of this Meeting – Initiate CEQA Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Process

Notice of Preparation (NOP) for California Tower

- NOP Issued February 26, 2021
- Announce that a Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has been initiated
- Describe the Proposed Project: California Tower
- Provide preliminary information on potential environmental effects

Scoping

- Obtain agency and public input on scope and content of the EIR
- Identify potential issues early in the environmental review process

Scoping Meeting

 Lead Agency may convene a meeting to consult with those concerned with environmental effects of the project

Draft EIR: Project Description and Objectives, Environmental Impact Analysis, Alternatives Analysis, Mitigation Measures	Aesthetics, Agriculture and Forestry, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Energy, Geology, Soils and Seismicity, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use, Noise, Population and Housing, Public Services, Recreation, Transportation, Utilities
Final EIR: Comments and Responses to Comments









UC DAVIS SACRAMENTO CAMPUS LONG RANGE PLANNING












LRDP 2020 UPDATE **NOVEMBER 2020**

Campus Boundary


